PHOTOGRAPHY /FILMING

For private use or school work:

With the permission of the staff at our reception, you can photograph and film in the museum's exhibitions for private use or to illustrate your own student work. You must not use flash, as many of our objects are sensitive.

If you want to use your photos in other ways than as a private person or in school work, you must apply for a permit to take photos or film in the museum's exhibitions. Museum staff must always be present when handling objects or when using extra lighting.

How do I apply for a permit? You apply by filling in the photography permit form and send it to us via e-mail to <u>eva.ahlstrom@ajtte.com</u> or by regular letter to Ájtte, Svenskt Fjäll- och Samemuseum Box 116 962 23 JOKKMOKK

We recommend that you have a permit ready upon arrival at the museum.

The press photos may only be published free of charge in editorial texts about Ájtte or about the museum's exhibitions. If the text mainly deals with something else, please contact the museum's photo archive.

Always state Ájtte and the photographer's name when using the images, e.g. Ájtte, Jan Gustavsson.
